Playwise Preschool Academy Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

Playwise Preschool Academy follows infection control recommendations made by the US CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) and the NC Department of Health and Human Services in regards to Covid-19. To ensure the safety of our staff, our campers, and our campers' families, the following measures are in currently in place at Playwise. ****Please note that due to ongoing changes in regulations regarding Covid-19 in our state and community, our Covid-19 policy may change prior to the start of summer camp.*

- During summer camp, Playwise has implemented a mask-optional policy. Parents may use their discretion to determine whether their child should wear a mask. All staff members will ensure that students follow parent preferences regarding mask-wearing.
- Staff and/or campers showing Covid-19 or any cold/flu-like symptoms will not be admitted for the day.
- As always, we require emergency contact numbers and access to communication with you while your child is in our care. We adhere to a strict policy of sending children home if we feel uncomfortable, in any way, regarding the spread of any germs.
- We require campers to use hand sanitizer at check-in and then wash hands when entering the building. We have increased the frequency of our teacher-monitored hand washing routines throughout our camp day.
- We have increased the time spent before, during, and after camp for sanitation of our classrooms, indoor/outdoor equipment and bathrooms (especially "high touch" areas, such as doorknobs, art supplies, toys, etc.).
- Children will need to bring their own labeled water bottles, as our water fountains will be disconnected until further notice. We can refill water bottles using store-bought, filtered water in our refrigerator.
- We require all of our campers to be fully potty trained. Please keep a change of clothing in a labeled plastic baggie in your child's backpack for emergency use.
- We maintain a closed-door policy, and parents are not allowed to enter the building unless planned in advance.
- We expect all staff and families in our Playwise community to practice preventative behaviors at home. This is the most important action that will prevent the spread of illness in our school. We must stress the importance of monitoring for and responding to the symptoms of colds/flu/Covid-19 at home. It is crucial that campers remain home when they, or anyone in their household, is sick with any cold/flu/Covid-like symptoms.

Consent to Risk

Thank you for your continued trust in our educational programs at Playwise Preschool Academy. As with the transmission of any communicable illness, like a cold or the flu, you may be exposed to Covid-19 at any time or in any place. Despite our careful attention to sterilization/disinfection, recommending the use of masks when indoors, and use of personal space, there is still a chance that you/your child could be exposed to an illness, including Covid-19, at our school.

Supplemental Health Questionnaire

According to the CDC, people with Covid-19 can display a wide range of symptoms, including:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever or chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Congestion or runny nose

The health and safety of our campers and staff is vital. Please consider the following questions when determining whether to send your child to camp. Responding to these questions truthfully will allow us to safely work together to help prevent the spread of Covid-19 to others in our school and community:

- Have you, your child, or any other acquaintances recently tested positive for Covid-19 or were diagnosed as having Covid-19 or any other communicable illness?
- Do you, your child or anyone in your household have ANY of the symptoms listed above?

I understand that if the answer to either of these questions is 'yes', my child will be asked to stay home.
